**STEWARDSHIP/ MEG COUPLES' MINUTE**  
**Conversion of the Purse - is tithing a priority for you?**  
 Submitted by Rev. O.T. Tomes

Malachi 3:8-10, Religious reformer Martin Luther observed that there are three conversions necessary: the conversion of the heart, the mind and the purse. Of the three, the purse can be the most difficult. Agreeing on money matters can be tough, and, for many couples, agreeing on tithes and offerings presents a special challenge.

A fundamental shift in attitude toward giving took place in our home when we changed the question we were asking each other. Rather than, "How much of our money should we give God," we learned to ask, "How much of God's money should we spend on ourselves?" The difference between these two questions was monumental for us. It helped us to remember that our financial resources are not partly ours and partly God's. Our income is **all** God's (see Exodus 19:5-6; Job 41:11; Psalm 24:1).

Although having this attitude is sometimes hard, especially when the bills pile up and the car needs to go to the mechanic - again! But if we trust in God, he will surely provide what we need to pay the bills... and then again some.
