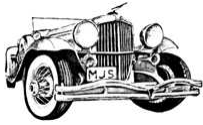

**Personal Reflections from O. T. & Irene  
“A love affair that has lasted for 48 years”**

After six years of dating I asked for Irene’s hand in marriage in December of 1961. We were married on June 24, 1962. In celebration of our 48<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary, we set sail from Miami, Fla., on a Caravel Destiny Cruise ship headed for Cozumel, Mexico and various ports along the way. On June 25<sup>th</sup> as we sat on the deck of the ship reminiscing of our lives together over the past 48 years Irene made a very profound statement: “Just think, on this date (25<sup>th</sup>) we were honeymooning in the Great Smokey Mountains along the Blue Ridge Parkway. 48 years later we are on a cruise ship with 3200 passengers and over 1100 staff persons gliding in the beautiful blue water and waves of one of God’s mighty oceans.” God has brought us a mighty long way!

As we sat there reminiscing of the wonder and the promise of a love we made to each other, I couldn’t even describe what I thought love was when I was first married. Forty eight years is a long time to be together with one person. It’s almost half of a century. All I knew in December of 1961 was that I wanted a love that would keep us together forever. Irene really felt those ‘love feelings’ a lot of people talk about. I’m not so sure I did; however, I knew that I loved her. I just knew it. Irene described me as a “logical lover.” I liked that. I still am. That’s me all right. We learned it’s all right to be different in the styles of love we had and how we expressed it, as long as we were adaptable enough to learn to put it into a package that the other person liked. I didn’t do that the first twenty years and that’s what created what we now call our valley of “love recessions.” Sometimes the wick of our candle of love got kind of low. But it never went out. We learned to **work** at our love and make it stronger. And it works, no matter what anyone says. Now that we are in our seventies we don’t know how many more years we’ll have to love one another. But we’ll make the most of them.

I’m not a poet, but I really enjoy reading. I found a statement sometime ago that puts into words some of my thoughts better than I can. Maybe this will have a message to the next generation right behind us. “It is love in old age, no longer blind, that is true love. For love’s highest intensity doesn’t necessarily mean its highest quality. Glamour and jealousy are gone; and the ardent caress, no longer needed, is valueless compared to the reassuring touch of a trembling hand. Passers-by commonly see little beauty in the embrace of young lovers on a park bench but the understanding smile of an old wife to her husband is one of the loveliest things in the world.”

That sums it all up. A lasting love affair is possible, and it’s also necessary. Commitment and love go hand in hand, just as commitment is a choice, so also is love. Love is not just something that happens. It must be cultivated so it can grow.
